## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, on November 1, 1969, the Arizona Highway Department was granted a revocable permit covering an access road, 50 feet wide and 250 feet in length, located in Lot 7, Section 5, T9N, R22E, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Navajo County, Arizona, to haul gravel from a gravel pit located on the Sitgreaves National Forest, and
- WHEREAS, this permit has expired and the Arizona Highway Department has requested that the permit be renewed for a period ending December 31, 1975, and
- WHEREAS, this land is located north of the Rim Road and the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe considers it advantageous to the Tribe to permit the Arizona Highway Department to use this short section of road.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a gratutious revocable permit be issued to the Arizona Highway Department for use of this access road.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to execute said permit.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
