RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there is a need to consolidate the Fire Control activity at the Whiteriver Airport, and
- WHEREAS, there are unexpended tribal funds to construct a new Fire Warehouse, not to exceed \$55,000.00 which will replace the present fire warehouse, and
- WHEREAS, the existing fire warehouse building No. 65 will be turned over to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for their use, and
- WHEREAS, the Government will rent the new building at the airport from the Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to sign the necessary documents to construct and rent the new fire control warehouse at a cost not to exceed \$55,000.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the construction costs be paid for from unexpended funds in the Tribal Forestry Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
