RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the HEW Committee has reviewed the Food Stamp and the Commodity Program, and
- WHEREAS, their recommendation to the Tribe was to adopt the Food Stamp Program, and
- WHEREAS, the starting date for the Food Stamp Program in Apache and Navajo Counties will be April 1, 1972 and Gila County in June.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the tribe wishes to notify the Department of Agriculture that they will enter into the said Food Stamp Program on the dates designated for each county.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized to signing any and all documents necessary to effectuate the program.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
