## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe had approved a single-base operation agreement with the Astro Aviation of Springerville, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent recommended an escape clause be included therein.

BE IT RESOLVED that before the Chairman is authorized to sign said agreement that a 30-day cancellation clause be included therein to provide that if the Astro Aviation fails to pay the fees or violate any condition in the agreement, that it be given 30 days within which to either pay the fee or comply with the condition; and if it fails to do so, the agreement shall be terminated.

The foegoing resolution was on April 19, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
