## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Northern Arizona Comprehensive Guidance Clinic, Inc. has presented an agreement to the tribe, which among other things, provide for said guidelines to be followed by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Guidance Clinic, Inc., and
- WHEREAS, the technical assistance and help is very valuable to the welfare of the Apache people of the guidance clinic.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized to sign the general agreement by and between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Northern Arizona Comprehensive Guidance Clinic, Inc., which agreement was read by the Tribal Council members.

Thenforegoing resolution was on April 19, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (j) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
