RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has invested several million dollars to implement a comprehensive outdoor recreation and tourism program, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe does not have adequate staff to provide technical assistance in improvising their outdoor recreation and tourism program, and
- WHEREAS, this technical assistance, if provided, will help the White Mountain Apache Tribe obtain additional employment and income for their people.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council does hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to expand its outdoor recreation and Tourism Technical Assistance Program so that much needed technical assistance can be furnished the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, purusant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
