RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Douglas Antonio, Edgar Kahn and Ambrose Bread have, for a long time, requested that Self-Help houses be built on their lands, and
- WHEREAS, their applications for said houses have never been honored, and
- WHEREAS, the Council feels that these men are entitled to have these houses built.
- BE IT RESOLVED that Douglas Antonio, Edgar Kahn and Ambrose Bread are hereby given top priority to have houses constructed on their lands immediately.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be given to the proper housing committee so that the wishes of the council can be carried out.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
