RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the First National Bank of Arizona presented to the council the plans for the new bank building to be constructed on its lease-hold premises, and

WHEREAS, the plans met the approval of the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the First National Bank of Arizona is hereby authorized to construct its new bank building on tribal lands according to the plans and specifications as presented to the council, a copy of which is in the Agency Superintendent's office.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
