## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Assembly of God Church has requested permission of the Tribal Council to grant an easement for the construction of a powerline to the Lower Cedar Creek Community, and
- WHEREAS, this powerline will benefit, not only the Assembly of God Church, but certain Cedar Creek Apache families.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent and the Chairman are hereby authorized to sign the necessary easement for a powerline right-of-way from its present location near Cedar Creek to the Lower Cedar Creek Community with said easement to be granted to the Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
