RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe requests that the contract be consummated between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, for the purpose of Administrative and General Assistance Program to employ eligible persons so that they may be employed while they receive general assistance, and

WHEREAS, such employees shall be provided with training and shall also supply public work for the communities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it wishes to negotiate a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the coming fiscal year 1973 starting July 1, 1972 and ending June 30, 1973, for the administration of the Tribal Work Experience Program, including the public work aspect of the General Assistance Program and including workmens compensation for participation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a Negotiation Committee be appointed of the following people: Ivan Kitcheyan, Tim C. Dye, West Anderson and Hal Butler

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
