RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Farmers Home Administration has been active in providing livestock loans to members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, this Agency has recently become active in providing much needed housing loans at various locations on the Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, it is indicated that the number of loan applications will increase substantially in the very near future, and
- WHEREAS, frequent contact with the FHA office is required to process and service the loan applications.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman be directed to write a letter to the State Director of the Farmers Home Administration, encouraging him to establish a branch office in Pinetop, Arizona.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman express his appreciation for the assistance and cooperation received from the Farmers Home Administration.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
