RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHERRAS, the University of Arizona has obtained funds to conduct a study on the Ecological changes in Ponderosa pine forest from controlled burning and wildfires, and

WHEREAS, it is advantageous to the Tribe to obtain this information to assist them in the management of their forested land.

BE IT DESOLVED that the University of Arizona is given permission to conduct this study and camp their personnel on the reservation during this otudy.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 924).
