DESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FCRT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there have been a series of discussions between Astro Aviation, Public Health Service, Council Committees, and the Bureau of Indian Affairs on the possibility of a joint ventureship between Astro Aviation and the Tribe on a contract to provide air ambulance Service out of Whiteriver, and various services to Fire Control, and

WHEREAS, more research and negotiations are required to consummate this arrangement.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Hountain Apache Tribe that the Council expresses an interest in this development and encourages all parties to expeditiously conclude the negotiations.

The foregoing resolution was on June 8, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
