RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there is at this time a great need for planning and implementation of our economic and social development, and
- WHEREAS, this work is more than can be handled alone by our contract Reservation Programs Position, and
- UHEREAS, the Indian Development District of Arizona Planner Position is responsible for overall planning and development, and
- WHEREAS, the incumbent of the Indian Development District of Arizona Planner Position is experienced only in roads, and is not working properly in his position, nor is the committee (Overall Economic Development Program) which was established to monitor his position, and
- WHEREAS, the position should be filled by a person educated and experienced in planning, business activities, and resource management.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Indian Development District of Arizona Planner Position be vacated immediately and recruitment of a replacement be initiated immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on June 8, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Hountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Hay 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 12, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
