

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION.**

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has considered the purchase of the Apache Construction Company, and

WHEREAS, the tribe consider it necessary that an appraisal be made to determine its worth and value of the equipment, and

WHEREAS, the tribe requests assistance from the Fort Apache Agency and the Phoenix Area Office to help determine the true value.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the Superintendent coordinate the review of the Apache Construction Company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an audit be made of the White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise for the years, 1970-71 Fiscal Year and 1971-72 Fiscal Year by the Phoenix Area Credit Office.

The foregoing resolution was on June 22, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 10, 1934 (40 Stat. 884).
