RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration, pursuant to (EDA Project No. 08-1-00604) has agreed to lend the tribe the sum of \$58,000.00 to defray the cost of the completion of the said Vocational School, and

WHEREAS, the tribe has agreed to retain title to said facility and to dedicate it to public use.

BE IT RESOLVED that in consideration of Economic Development Administration lending it the sum of \$58,000.00 that it hereby covenants and agrees that it will retain title of the Vocational School Facility (EDA Project No. 08-1-00604) to be constructed by this project and for its useful life, such facility will be dedicated to a public use.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
