MESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

THEREAS, there is a need to construct Green Belts (Fire Breaks) on the reservation to protect the Tribe's resources and investments, and

WHEREAS, the Branch of Forestry has proposed initial Green Balts around Hon Dah Complex and McNary townsite.

BY IT RESOLVED that these Green Belts be constructed and maintained.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any timber not harvested by Fort Apache Timber Company be sold for pulpwood.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Triba, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amende Constitution and By-Laus of the Tribe, ratified by the Triba June 27, 1950 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (43 Stat. 904).
