## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has a used 1969 Ford, four-door sedan and a used 1970 Mercury, four-door sedan which are surplus, and

WHEREAS, a greater cash return to the Tribe can be obtained from these two units by direct sale rather than to trade them in on new units.

BE IT RESOLVED that the 1969 Ford, four-door sedan be sold to Carl Nosie for \$700.00 and the 1970 Mercury, four-door sedan be sold to Lafe Altaha for \$1,800.00.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
