## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, at the Special Meeting of the Tribal Council on August 7, 1972, the Council approved unanimously Resolution No. 72-130 and Resolution No. 72-131, and

WHEREAS, the Council members have returned to the communities and discussed the settlement of the claims in Docket No. 22-D and 22-J, and

WHEREAS, the communities' vote was favorable to the council action.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the action taken in Resolution No. 72-130 and Resolution No. 72-131 is hereby reaffirmed by the action of the Council by the following vote:

Nine for and one absent, none abstaining, the Council Chairman not voting.

The foregoing resolution was on August 28, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
