RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee has recommended to the Tribal Council its desires to have removed from the Fort Apache Agency staff, Mr. Omer B. Whittaker, a Criminal Investigator, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that Mr. Whittaker's character is not fitting and compatible with the Law and Order operation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent and the Area Director have Mr. Whittaker removed from the Fort Apache Agency staff as soon as possible.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this position be retained at the Agency and refilled as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on August 28, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
