RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there has been no person on committees, who in the past has approved travel vouchers for the Judicial Department of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that some control should be exercised of the said travel, and
- WHEREAS, by resolution, the Chairmen of all committees now have the authority to approve travel vouchers for members of their respective committees, and
- WHEREAS, the tribe is of the opinion that the Chairman of the Law and Order Committee should likewise approve the travel vouchers of the Judicial Department.
- BE IT RESOLVED that henceforth, no Tribal Judges or Associate Judges shall receive compensation for travel unless their voucher for travel has been approved by the Chairman of the Law and Judicial Planning Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on September 18, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
