RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by Resolution No. 69-131 approved the formal agreement between the Tribe and the Salt River Water Users Association and the Salt River Project Agriculture Improvement and Power District, et al, and
- WHEREAS, the said resolution provided that the Tribal Chairman sign the said agreement, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that an additional study should be conducted in order to ensure that the tribe would receive adequate water for all of its future uses, and
- WHEREAS, the bureau has appropriated the sum of \$50,000.00 to conduct this study.
- BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 69-131 is hereby rescinded.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized to request that a study be made of the proposed contract between the tribe and the Salt River Water Users Association, and that a study be made of all of the future needs of water by the tribe, and that a report be presented to the Tribal Council of the results of these studies.

The foregoing resolution was on September 18, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
