RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN .APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, at the meeting of the Sunrise Enterprise Board on September 7, 1972, it was decided an emergency existed and to supply adequate housing for the operation and maintenance of the hotel and ski enterprises, and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise Board requested the Tribal Council that \$70,000.00 be appropriated immediately from any source to eliminate this emergency.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$70,000.00 be appropriated to resolve this emergency.

The foregoing resolution was on September 18, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
