RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, our Tribal Attorney, Barry DeRose, has performed good and faithful services for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney submitted, to all the Council members, a copy of a new Tribal Attorney Contract some three months ago, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has studied the contract for the past three months and by its actions has extended the old contract until the council meeting of September 18, 1972, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council decided at that meeting to grant the Tribal Attorney, a new three-year contract.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized, on behalf of the Tribal Council, to execute a new Tribal Attorney Contract with Barry DeRose for a three-year period beginning September 18, 1972 and terminating on September 17, 1975 at a salary of \$1250.00 per month, said contract to be in the same form as read and studied by all the Tribal Council members.

The foregoing resolution was on September 18, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
