RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there is a need to re-locate the Roads Shop to give greater parking space and area to the Tribal Operation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe elects to construct a new Roads Shop Building and rent it to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and
- WHEREAS, the site selection is to be agreed to by the Land Board, and
- WHEREAS, the selected yard is to be adequate to take care of future tribal needs and expansion of the Roads operation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$15,000.00 be used that is now included in the Tribal Budget for Roads to construct the said Shop Building and grounds to be rented to the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing resolution was on October 3, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
