RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, in the White Mountain Apache Head Start Program budget there are sufficient funds in which to effectuate an \$800.00 savings, and
- WHEREAS, the sum of \$800.00 is needed to defray the cost of enabling four teachers to attend classes in order to complete their high school equivalency, and
- WHEREAS, these four teachers would then be qualified to teach in the Head Start Program, and
- WHEREAS, more White Mountain Apache teachers are needed in the Head Start Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Head Start Program budget is hereby amended to transferring the sum of not to exceed \$800.00 to defray the cost of four teachers securing their high school diploma.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$800.00 is to be provided by a savings within the entire Head Start Program budget.

The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
