RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has accepted the recommendations of the Recreation Enterprise for establishing hunting, fishing and camping permits for the 1973 season, and

WHEREAS, the basic schedule was approved by the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise in the minutes of the meeting held on October 28, 1972, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe's interest is in improved game management and increased resource revenues.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following fee schedule is adopted:

Guide Permit: \$100.00 (Dogs allowed only with valid

Lion: \$25.00 - Arizona Resident

\$50.00 - Non-Resident

Antelope: \$75.00 - Arizona Resident

\$100.00 - Arizona Resident \$150.00 - Out of State Resident

Special Permit:

Christmas Tree Lake

Adults - \$3.00 per day
