RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council on April 26, 1972 passed a Resolution No. 72-56, approving the Budget for the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise for the Fiscal Year 1972-1973, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors met on October 28, 1972 and recommended the Fiscal Year 1972-1973 Budget be amended to provide additional funds for the freight and repair of the surplus vehicles acquired by the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the Enterprise Board of Directors recommends the Budget be amended by the addition of \$10,000.00 to the Maintenance and Repair of Vehicles and \$10,000.00 to the contingency account.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council approves the two amendments:

- To provide an increase of \$10,000.00 for the Maintenance and Repair of Vehicles.
- 2. To increase the Reserve for Contingencies by \$10,000.00.

The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
