RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 70-100 adopted on June 10, 1970 by the Tribal Council set aside the parcel of land presently occupied by the First National Bank of Arizona for use by the Employment Security Commission of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the new First National Bank of Arizona is nearly completed and they will be vacating their present site.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to execute a lease with the Employment Security Commission of Arizona covering the site presently occupied by a bank office trailer, owned by the First National Bank of Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the lease shall be for a five (5) year period at an annual rental fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00).

The foregoing resolution was on December 6, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
