## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the San Carlos Apache Tribe has recommended to the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the 4.9 million dollars, Apache Claims Award be divided equally by the San Carlos Apache Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is of the opinion that additional study is needed before any agreement is reached.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the offer by the San Carlos Apache Tribe to divide the claims funds equally is hereby rejected.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that further study be made to determine just what percentage the White Mountain Apache Tribe should receive.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
