RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Public Health Service Project No. 70-126 has been completed, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has requested that Public Health do additional work within the project area, and

WHEREAS, the Project No. 70-126 reflects a savings of \$50,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the proposed amendment of \$50,000.00 be accepted as an amendment to the Indian Health Service Project No. 70-126.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Project Amendment show the project submitted as amending the project for the balance of the houses in the north and south, Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
