## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been selected as one of the participants for Technical Assistance Management Development provided by the Office of Economic Opportunity through its grantee, Navajo Community College and Contractor, American Indian Consultants, Inc., and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is of the opinion that it would be beneficial to participate in said program.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized to sign an agreement to request Technical Assistance Management Development.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe does endorse this program and shall cooperate in every way possible in the study to be made with the understanding; however, any assistance shall be rendered to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, free of charge.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1973 duly adoptedmby a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
