- WHEREAS, Joseph Clawson has been employed by the Mainstream Program for two years, and
- WHEREAS, the source of funding for training of Mr. Joseph Clawson has been depleted, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council thinks it is in the best interest of the Tribe to employ Joseph Clawson.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that Mr. Joseph Clawson is employed from Budget Account No. 01-34-7150.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Clawson be terminated when this account is exhausted.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
