RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the Sunrise Hotel, and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Sunrise Hotel has submitted and recommended approval by the Tribal Council of a general and operating budget for the hotel for August 1, 1972 to April 30, 1973 and said budget has been prepared and recommended in accordance with the Plan of Operation for the enterprise.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the budget for the general operating expense in the amount of \$379,544.00 is hereby approved for the operation of the Sunrise Hotel from August 1, 1972 to April 30, 1973.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
