RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned about having adequate information on the Tribe's water needs, and
- WHEREAS, Stevens, Thompson and Runyan, Inc. came to the Tribe highly recommended by Hans Walker of the Washington Office, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes the Stevens, Thompson and Runyan, Inc.
 program a report requesting amounts of funding needed for a
 complete comprehensive study of the Tribe's water needs, and
- WHEREAS, Stevens, Thompson and Runyan, Inc. has agreed to pursue sources of funding for the comprehensive water study.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that Stevens, Thompson and Runyan, Inc. are hereby
 authorized to prepare, on behalf of and in cooperation
 with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, a proposal for funding
 of a future water resources study of the Fort Apache Indian
 Reservation at a cost not to exceed \$1,000.00.

The foregoing resolution was on January 22, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
