## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Community Action Programs, OEO, HUD, EDA and EEA have been prevalent on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for some time, and
- WHEREAS, these programs have helped raise the standard of living and furnished much needed homes and jobs for the White Mountain Apache people, and
- WHEREAS, the absolvent of any of these programs would hinder the progress of our people, and
- WHEREAS, even with these programs, the White Mountain Apaches per capita income and standard of living is far below that of the average non-Indian.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the President and our Congressional Delegation are hereby implored to continue all the above programs in effect on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
