RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council considers the present numerous housing committees ineffective, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to make a more efficient housing operation by consolidating all housing committees, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that all housing committees be dissolved, and
- WHEREAS, the duties and responsibilities of all the dissolved housing committees be assigned to the White Mountain Apache Tribal Housing Authority.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all housing committees be dissolved and the duties and responsibilities be accepted by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Housing Authority.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Carl Nosie be appointed to the White Mountain Apache Tribal Housing Authority to fill the position vacated by Mrs. Delta Brewer.

The foregoing resolution was on February 8, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
