## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Michael W. Everett came before the Tribal Council to discuss the Teenage Drinking Problem, and
- WHEREAS, after a thorough discussion, the Tribal Council through their White Mountain Apache Tribal Alcoholic Program has endeavored to combat this problem, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council would welcome any additional assistance from any source to further the educational endeavors of this program.
- E IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Council endorses the program submitted by Michael W. Everett.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Michael W. Everett apply to the Federal Government for an assistance program of about \$70,000.00 in the name of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this program be supervised and carried on with the assistance of Michael W. Everett and the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council through their Tribal Alcoholic Program.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) and (j) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
