## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, standing and down snags and minor volume of green blowdown timber have been left after cutting in the Reservation Spruce Bark Beetle Logging Unit, and
- WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company has completed logging of this unit,
- WHEREAS, other logging contractors have expressed interest in buying this snag material, and
- WHEREAS, Section B3 of the Fort Apache Timber Company Plan of Operation allows the Tribe to sell to others, forest products which Fort Apache Timber Company cannot manufacture, process or produce, and
- WHEREAS, there is an estimated 500,000 board feet of snag material that the Tribe can offer for sale.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe consents to the advertised sale of the Westfork Snag Logging Unit at a minimum appraised rate of \$5.00/MBM, gross sale.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of '9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
