RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Central Tribe has always had the expense of repairs for the Whiteriver Tribal Rodeo Grounds. and
- WHEREAS, the using parties and associations have never contributed to the maintenance of the rodeo grounds, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to reduce the expenses from the Central Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that each individual, group, or association using the Whiteriver Rodeo grounds will contribute ten per cent (10%) of the funds collected to the Central Tribe for maintenance and repairs of said rodeo grounds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all arrangements for the Whiteriver Rodeo grounds be approved by the Council and that the ten per cent (10%) use fee be paid to the Tribal Administrative Officer in the Tribal Business Office for the use in maintenance and improvement of the rodeo grounds.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
