RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on July 1, 1963, the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Director, Arizona State Museum, representing the Department of Anthropology of the University of Arizona entered into a lease for an Archaeological Field School in the Grasshopper area, and

WHEREAS, this lease will expire on June 30, 1973, and

WHEREAS, the University of Arizona has requested a new lease and have offered a lease rental rate of \$500.00 per annum.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized to enter into a lease with the University of Arizona for a period of five years at a rental rate of \$500.00 per annum.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
