RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to participate to a greater extent in the Social Services program, and
- WHEREAS, the facilities to permit this participation is a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has successfully completed partial contracts for the Tribal Work Experience Program, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to enter into another contract with the Fureau of Indian Affairs in the amount of \$297,607.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman be authorized to negotiate and sign all necessary documents and to enter into Tribal Work Experience contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract be extended from July 1, 1973, to June 30, 1974, and in the amount of about \$297,607

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1973, duly adopted by a vote of E for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1950 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1950, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 12, 1934 (40 Stat. 904).
