## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE HOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Jountain Apache Tribe has been informed by ICAP that no funds will be available for the VISTA volunteers, effective June 30, 1973, and
- WHEREAS, ICAP request the Thite buntain Apache Tribe to assume sponsorship of the two present VISTA workers, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe accepts the sponsorship of the two VISTA workers, knowing that ICAP funds will not be available after June 30, 1973, and
- WHEREAS, it was explained to ICAP that the Tribe could not contribute to one of the vehicles and maintenance due to lack of tribal funds.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Lountain Apache Tribe that they will extend sponsorship of the two VISTA workers presently working on the reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds will not be available for the continued rental of the GSA vehicle now in use.

The foregoing resolution was on June 6, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 1 against by the Iribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
