RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, published in Code of Federal Regulations, Title 25, Section 221.180 through 221.184 in July 1963 to change project category,
- WHEREAS, this change in CFR Title 25 required Indian Land Owners to pay a fee when operating a form, and
- WHEREAS, all unics of the project are small garden-like subsistance units that will not produce any sizeable income to the individual, and
- WHEREAS, payment required by either the Tribe or individuals would work a financial hardship and the unpaid charges are accumulating as a lien against the land with no prospect of being paid.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Bureau of Indian Affairs change the present project category from Category II to Category III.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs revise C.F.R. Title 25 Section 221.180 through 221.184 to delete the Tribe or Individual payment since condition do not permit any economic return.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

On February 2, 1970, we transmitted to you Resolution No. 70-12 of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concerning the assessable status of the Fort Apache Irrigation Project. In our letter of transmittal we advised you that this project in its present state fits the definition of a Category III project and should be placed in that category until such a time as the White River Extension of the Project is constructed and economic sized units are developed. Based on this we recommended that Title 25, Chapter I of the Code of Federal Regulations be amended by the deletion of Section 221.180 through 221.184 in their entirety.

Enclosed is another resolution on this adopted by the Tribal Council on August 2, 1973, and the Superintendent's transmittal of August 22, 1973, requesting our guidance for immediate and/or necessary action to correct this situation.

We believe correction requires that the appropriate Sections be deleted from the Code of Federal Regulations and ask that you take the necessary action to accomplish this.
