## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the tribe now has on deposit available Revenue Sharing Funds to advance to the General Livestock Association, the sum of \$21,000.00 to build sale pens at Haystack and Apache Springs, and

WHEREAS, there are some 400 cattle owners who would benefit by the utilization of these pens.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Administrative Officer are hereby authorized to advance the sum of \$21,000.00 from Revenue Sharing Funds on deposit to the General Livestock Association.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 4 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
