RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 73-134, the Tribal Council authorized the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise to use the old Roads Shop area at a monthly rental of \$300.00, and
- WHEREAS, it will cost the said enterprise in excess of \$6500.00 to rehabilitate the premises, and
- WHEREAS, it is the wish of the Tribal Council that the rental payments be deferred for a period of two years in order to permit the enterprise to amortize its rehabilitating said building.
- BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 73-134 is hereby amended to provide that rental payments shall be deferred until the first day of September, 1975 and that beginning on said September, 1975, monthly rental shall be \$300.00 per month plus all utilities, insurance, fencing and maintenance.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the enterprise shall begin immediately to pay its own utilities, insurance, fencing and maintenance.

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
