RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, DeVore Thompson has requested a certain area to be designated by the Council on Sunrise Lake, and
- WHEREAS, the Council wants to encourage individual members of the tribe to get into business.
- BE IT RESOLVED that DeVore Thompson shall be granted an area on the Lake upon which to construct said marina.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that prior to any construction being commenced, that said DeVore Thompson present to the council for its approval, a plat and area and building to be constructed and an estimate of the cost.

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
