## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, to qualify for the benefits of a Redevelopment District under the requirements of the Economic Development Administration, an Overall Economic Development Plan (OEDP) must be organized for their approval, and

WHEREAS, the current O.E.D.P. is outdated and EDA has specified that a new one be compiled to continue qualification, and

WHEREAS, the goals and priorities for overall development of the reservation must be determined by the people themselves, as represented by a committee selected by the Tribal Council, and entitled the OEDP Committee.
