RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Council had previously approved the archaeological clearance for all of the HUD conventional mutual-help building sites, except nine, and

WHEREAS, further study has been made on these additional nine sites, and

WHEREAS, the tribe has investigated these nine additional sites in question and has recommended an archaeological clearance for all of them.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Fort Apache Indian Reservation that an archaeological clearance is hereby made for all of the following proposed sites for Arizona 16-11, 16-12, 16-14, 16-15, 16-16, 16-18, 16-19, 16-20, 16-21 and 16-22.

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
