RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe now has on deposit available Revenue Sharing Funds to advance to the North Fork, Whiteriver and Canyon Day Communities to build and improve badly needed facilities within their district and county, and
- WHEREAS, there are some 2,000 people who would benefit by the utilization of these badly needed facilities, and
- WHEREAS, these communities lie in Gila and Navajo Counties receiving \$187,215.00, for and to support the economic and social development of American Indians on reservations and Alaska Natives.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Administrative Officer are hereby authorized to advance the sum of \$46,700.00 from Revenue Sharing Funds on deposit to North Fork, Whiteriver and Canyon Day Communities for and to support their economic and social development of the

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for 1 abstained 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
